The University of Massachusetts is a world-class public research university system committed to advancing knowledge and transforming lives through teaching, research and service. With four nationally ranked comprehensive campuses, a premier medical school and a justice-driven law school, UMass educates 74,000 students, has more than half a million alumni, conducts \$813 million in annual research, and generates \$8.3 billion in annual economic impact.
